



This letter is to inform all Operating Engineers of Local 181 that effective July 1, 2024 GenTox LLC will begin drug and alcohol testing for all members who test under the Southwestern Indiana Building Trades Policy. We have three convenient local locations, and many other locations area wide. At each of our facilities we have employees dedicated to our local union members. Each of our staff members understand the urgency of getting our union members in and out as quickly as possible, and we strive to make that happen.

Since all the drug and alcohol testing will be kept in-house, we can provide a more private testing experience for each of you. We have staff that will help you process prescription medication, and any non-negative test results that you may experience.

Our goal here at GenTox is to make this transition as seamless as possible. We will mail your random letter to you and follow that up with a phone call. We will also mail you a reminder letter for your annual CCS card. All of these letters will have *Local 181* and the words *Random* or *Annual* stamped on the outside of the envelope to ensure you will recognize the importance of the letter.
